Abelardo Morell

As charming as a flea market Braque, Morell's cubistic photogram Still Life With Pears features silhouettes of a spoon, fork, and vases framed by angular black lines. Elsewhere, his camera obscura images include a projection of the Philadelphia Museum's facade upon one of its own de Chirico paintings—a real-world neoclassical colonnade layered over the surrealist's foreboding Italian cityscape. Almost as strange is a straightforward shot entitled \$7 Million (2006): Light filters through thick bundles of \$100 bills stacked as haphazardly as bales in a hayloft.
